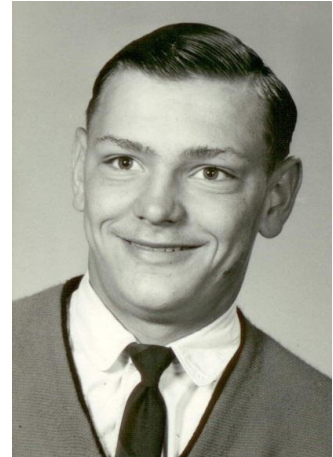




## Karl Steve Christensen

Steve Christensen, 60, of Sidney and formerly of Ogallala, died Sunday, February 17, 2013 in his home.
