Rocky Ford, 40, of Big Springs, died Sunday, February 5, 2012, in Regional West Medical Center in Scottsbluff.

Rocky was born August 13, 1971 in Grant, Nebr., the son of Rodney and Tiny (Luedke) Ford. He attended school in Big Springs, graduating from high school in 1989.

Rocky was a meat cutter at the Big Springs grocery store before moving to Lincoln. He worked as a meat cutter in several stores there. In 2003 Rocky moved to Denver and was employed as the assistant manager and meat cutter for Albertsons Store.



In 2005 he returned to Big Springs and farmed for Stan Rhoades and Kenny Rhoades. His hobbies included hunting, fishing, and watching football games.

Preceding him in death was his father Rodney in 2005 and his grandfather Clyde Ford in 2008.

Survivors include his mother Tiny Ford and his sister Heather Ford, both of Big Springs; sister Tammy Moore of Ogallala; two brothers Mickey Humphrey of Florida and Todd Ford and his wife Camille of Houston, Tx. Grandmother Grace Ford of Ogallala and several nieces and nephews.
