Marilyn Hahn, 83, of Ogallala, died Monday, September 3, 2012, in Great Plains Regional Medical Center in North Platte.

Marilyn was born March 18, 1929 in Wausa, Nebr., the daughter of LaVerne and Alice (Bobenmoyer) Thomas. Marilyn graduated from Hartington High School in 1946.

After attending Wayne State College Marilyn taught school in northeastern Nebraska for one year. She moved to Ogallala where she met Glenn Hahn.



On September 30, 1950 Marilyn married Glenn Hahn at St. Paul's Lutheran Church. The couple made their home in Roscoe until 1953. They moved to Lakewood, Colo. and Marilyn was employed at various jobs. In 1979 Marilyn began working in accounting for the Bureau of Land Management, retiring in 1991.

In 2007 the Hahns moved to Ogallala. Marilyn was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church. Her hobbies included playing cards, doing crossword puzzles, and gardening and she was a sports enthusiast. Marilyn belonged to the Ogallala Moose Lodge and the Ogallala Elks Lodge #1760.

Preceding her in death were her parents, brother Verlyn Thomas, sister and brother-in-law Vernise and Obed Nielsen; and sister and brother-in-law Zada and Carl Jensen.

Survivors include her husband Glenn Hahn of Ogallala, her son Kevin Hahn and his wife Bonnie of Loveland, Colo. Two sisters-in-law Jacque Cunningham of Ogallala and LaDonna Thomas of Newcastle, Nebr. Two grandchildren: Cody Hahn and Kylee Hahn, both of Loveland, Colo. and numerous nieces and nephews.

The family chose cremation. The memorial service will be Friday, September 7, at 10 a.m. in St. Paul's Lutheran Church with Rev. John Stubenrouch officiating. A private family graveside inurnment will be held at a later date. A memorial has been established to St. Paul's Lutheran Church.
