Wanda Mueller, 81, longtime Ogallala resident, died Thursday, November 18, 2010 at Indian Hills Manor.

Wanda Pearl Mueller was born April 30, 1929 in Chappell, the daughter of Archie and Mae Jeppson Jacobson. Wanda attended school in Oshkosh, graduating from high school in 1945.

She attended college at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. Wanda returned to reside in Oshkosh and was employed as a lab tech for the Ogallala Medical Clinic for several years. She married Clifton Buske and the couple made their home on the Buske family ranch near Lisco.
